

MEMBERSHIP CODE OF ETHICS

- 1. A member shall encourage students and public to recognize better education in dance, and strive to make this knowledge obtainable.
- 2. A member shall not discredit, malign, cause dissension, or use personal malicious gossip, or any other form of derogation, in regard to another school or teacher or the organization.
- 3. A member shall not use false or misleading statements to advise the material taught in the school.
- 4. A member shall refrain from making false statements or claims to past or present affiliations.
- 5. A member shall not open a school or solicit students while on the staff of a member's studio, unless mutually agreed.
- 6. A member shall not, through personal contacts by himself or his representatives or students solicit students who are attending another school.
- 7. A member should remember that programs and advertisements bearing your school name should be symbolic of the work taught in your school.
- 8. A member shall not through personal contact by himself or his representatives solicit faculty of another school without permission from the director of that school.
